Approve the signing of the Office Lease Agreement (SAIF Contract No. 7532) for the rental of approximately 2,125-square feet of space on the 6th floor of the Parkway building located at 440 Church St. SE, Salem Oregon for a term of 60 months.

Summary: The Salem Housing Authority needs additional office space for effective operations. The State Accident Insurance Fund (SAIF) Corporation has office space available for lease at the building located at 440 Church Street, SE, Salem, Oregon (known as the Parkway building, which is the same building the City is temporarily housed at). Staff have reached tentative agreement to enter into an Office Lease Agreement with SAIF for a term of 60 months, beginning on July 1, 2026.
