Honorable Council Members:

The Glenn Gibson Creeks Watershed Council fully supports the proposed replacement of a culvert on Glenn Creek with a bridge. The Creek is critical habitat for federally listed Upper Willamette steelhead. A bridge with a stream simulation stream bed will more fully allow refuge by juvenile steelhead during high flows when fish use is critical. This type of action demonstrates Salem's commitment to healthy floodplain conditions and protection of the natural environment that are important to many in the City.
