## END NOTES TO CHANGE ORDERS:

- **1. Change Order No. 2 adds \$97,500:** Provides for a change to the billing from quarterly net amounts to monthly actuals. This is for fiscal year 2023-24.
- **2.** Change Order No. 1 adds \$67,246: Provides for an additional phase to the project for final design, permitting, and construction support.
- **3. Change Order No. 3 adds \$33,000:** Provides for the removal and replacement of the existing coating around the dollar plate, rusting i-beams contacting the dollar plate, and the fill pipe at the top of the reservoir.
- **4. Change Order No. 2 adds \$37,769.39:** Provides for additional costs incurred due to the time constraints on the Commercial St Paving Bond Project, requiring completion by May 1.
- **5.** Change Order No. 5 adds \$46,228: Provides for the following changes: sample station pipe changes, overexcavation of unsuitable material and replacement with 3/4" 0 aggregate base, streetlight conduit and wire replacement, 4-inch scum pipe repair, and 42-inch pipe offset correction.
- **6. Change Order No. 1 adds \$334,882.14:** Provides for new radios needed for the new fleet of ambulances.
- 7. Change Order No. 1 adds \$489,000: Provides for new monitors needed for the new fleet of ambulances.
- **8. Change Order No. 2 adds \$28,000:** Underestimated usage for fiscal year 2023-24.
- **9. Change Order No. 1 adds \$25,000:** Provides for the cost of two new 3-way valves equipped with electric operators to replace existing worn out units.
- **10.** Change Order No. 8 adds \$43,000: Provides for the annual maintenance cost for the public safety analysis portion.
