Drug Prevention, Treatment, and Enforcement in Salem

PREVENT

Decrease drug use and increase health in children, youth and adults

- ▶ Avoid and deter mis-use & disorder
- ▶ Redirect / divert from risky behavior
- ▶ Build resiliency to reduce the likelihood of risky or harmful behavior
- ▶ Improve system coordination

TREAT

Decrease drug-related deaths

- ▶ Get people the help needed to recover

ENFORCE

Increase drug seizures and track trends to inform activity
Reduce drug-related violent crime; complaints of activity; repeat offenders (livability impacts from drug availability and use)
Increase capacity for public safety

- ▶ Reduce / Eliminate flow of drugs
- ▶ Hold those who are distributing accountable and deter others

GOALS

Promote and facilitate community education – substance use and misuse prevention for youth, provide programs as alternatives/divert from behavior, and build resiliency; participate in regional network

GOALS

Provide triage response, intervene, and get connected to help for recovery

- » 9-1-1

Enforce laws

- » Police Department

GOALS

Support recovery

- » Salem Health
- » 9-8-8, Bridgeway
- » Schools
- » (County) LEAD, Addiction Treatment
- » Drug Court/STAR
- » (State)

GOALS

Enforce laws, prosecute and reform

- » (County) District Attorney, Sheriff, Public Safety Coordinating Council, Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion (LEAD)
- » (Federal) ATF, FBI, DEA
- » (State) Department of Justice, Oregon State Police

GAPS

- » 2 officers to supplement prevention & enforcement
- » Prevention Education Strategy
- » Regional Network for Settlement Recipients
- » Cross-Sector Youth Prevention Network

GAPS

- » Beds for care and recovery; specific for kids
- » Data sharing system-wide outcomes; re: overdose

GAPS

- » Jail space
- » Public defenders
- » Prosecutorial resources
- » (Same 2) officers to supplement prevention and enforcement
- » Increase use of treatment referrals
