

RESOLUTION NO. 2220

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR 2018-2019 HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP FUNDING to IMPLEMENT A SECURITY DEPOSIT PROGRAM TO ASSIST LOW-INCOME HOUSEHOLDS

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of Salem is desirous of obtaining funds from the City of Salem Urban Development Department in the amount of \$90,000 under the Federal Housing and Community Development Act as amended, and

WHEREAS, the City of Salem requires a resolution from the applicant's governing body authorizing submission of City of Salem HOME Investment Partnership Program application; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Housing Authority is authorized to submit an application for FY 2018-2019 HOME Investment Partnership Program application to the City of Salem Urban Development Department to provide a combined program including Security Deposit to support low-income households with resources to pay some or all of the security deposit needed to move into a new housing unit; and

Section 2. The Housing Authority Board of Commissioners hereby designates and authorizes the Executive Director or designee as the official to sign and file all applications and forms and execute agreements to submit an application for and accept funding through the City of Salem Urban Development Department HOME Investment Partnership Program for a Security Deposit Program to assist low-income households to move into a new housing unit.

Section 3. The resolution is effective upon adoption.
