

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-19

A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO RECEIVE A SHARE OF CERTAIN REVENUES FROM THE STATE OF OREGON GENERAL FUND IN FY 2027

Whereas, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 221.770, a share of certain revenues from the State General Fund are to be apportioned among and distributed to the cities of Oregon for general purposes; and

Whereas, in order for a city of this state to be included in apportionments or receive distributions under ORS 221.770, the city shall:

(a) Enact an ordinance or resolution expressing its election to receive said distribution; and

(b) Hold a public hearing, after adequate public notice, before the budget committee for the city, at which citizens have the opportunity to provide written and oral comment on the possible and proposed uses of the distributions, including offset against property tax levies by the city for the fiscal year; and

(c) Hold a public hearing, after adequate public notice, before the city council, at which citizens have the opportunity to provide written and oral comment to, and ask questions of, the city council on the possible and proposed uses of the distributions in relation to the entire budget for the city for the fiscal year, including possible offset against property tax levies by the city for the fiscal year; and

(d) Have levied a property tax for the year preceding the year in which revenue sharing is due; and

Whereas, after adequate public notice, the required hearings were held before the Budget Committee on April 29, 2026, and before the City Council on June 8, 2026; and

Whereas, the City of Salem levied a property tax for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Salem, Oregon, elects to receive certain revenues from the State General Fund for the fiscal year 2026-2027 pursuant to ORS 221.770.

Section 2. The City Recorder is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Oregon Department of Administrative Services and certify to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services that public hearings were held as stated above not later than July 31, 2026.

Section 3. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
