

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-35**

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING FY 2022 SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET 1 FOR THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON, AMENDING THE ADOPTED BUDGET FOR THE GENERAL FUND BY INCREASING EXPENDITURE APPROPRIATION AUTHORITY AND REVENUES.

**Whereas**, ORS 294.471(1)(b) authorizes the adoption of a supplemental budget as necessary to respond to a pressing necessity that could not be reasonably foreseen when preparing the original budget or a previous supplemental budget for the current year or current budget period and that requires prompt action; and

**Whereas**, on February 13, 2021, Oregon Governor Kate Brown declared a state of emergency in multiple counties, including Marion and Polk Counties, due to winter storm conditions; and

**Whereas**, effective February 14, 2021, the City declared a state of emergency due to winter storm conditions; and

**Whereas**, appropriate expenditure authority is required to maintain compliance with Oregon budget law to; and

**Whereas**, ORS 294.481(1) authorizes adoption of a supplemental budget under these circumstances.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The City Council hereby adopts a supplemental budget for the General Fund for FY 2022 as set forth in “Exhibit A” and “Exhibit B,” which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

**Section 2.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
