ORDINANCE BILL NO. 1-25

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SALEM-WILLAMETTE VALLEY AIRPORT;
AMENDING SRC SECTIONS 9.005, 9.040, 9.095, 9.100, 9.120, 9.215, 9.240, and Appendix I
of SRC chapter 9.

The City of Salem ordains as follows:

Section 1. SRC chapter 9 is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and by
this reference incorporated herein.

Section 2. Findings. The Salem-Willamette Valley Airport is geographically located in the
center of Oregon’s Willamette Valley and serves as a transportation hub for commercial,
military, emergency response, and general aviation services for not only the Salem metropolitan
area but the greater Willamette Valley. The establishment of commercial passenger air service at
Salem Municipal Airport in October 2023 reflects the demands of a larger, more regional
passenger market. The imposition of additional landing fees and aircraft parking fees will ensure
continued viability of the airport. The amendment to the Salem Revised Code is in the best
interest of the public.

Section 3. Codification. In preparing this ordinance for publication and distribution, the
City Recorder shall not alter the sense, meaning, effect or substance of this ordinance, but
within such limitations, may:

- (a) Renumber sections and parts of sections of the ordinance;
- (b) Rearrange sections;
- (c) Change reference numbers to agree with renumbered chapters, sections or other parts;
- (d) Delete references to repealed sections;
- (e) Substitute the proper subsection, section or chapter, or other division numbers;
- (f) Change capitalization and spelling for the purpose of uniformity;
- (g) Add headings for purposes of grouping like sections together for ease of reference; and
- (h) Correct manifest clerical, grammatical or typographical errors.

Section 4. Severability. Each section of this ordinance, and any part thereof, is
severable, and if any part of this ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent
jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
