

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-32**

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE PUBLIC NEED TO ACQUIRE EASEMENTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A PEDESTRIAN CROSSING ON LANCASTER DRIVE NE BETWEEN WATSON AVENUE NE AND GLENDALE AVENUE NE.

**Whereas**, for the purposes of the Lancaster-Watson Pedestrian Crossing Project (“Project”), it is necessary for the City of Salem (“City”) to acquire temporary construction easements and traffic signal and traffic signing easements over certain real property depicted on “Exhibit 1,” which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference (“the Properties”); and

**Whereas**, the Project is an approved capital improvement project currently being designed for construction; and

**Whereas**, for the public purposes of improving the streets within the City, including the construction of the Project, the City Council has deemed necessary the acquisition of certain property rights, which the City is authorized by law to acquire.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The City does hereby find the Project to be in the public interest and declares a public need for the easements in order to construct the public improvements for the Project.

**Section 2.** The City shall negotiate to acquire easements from those persons or entities with property interests depicted on “Exhibit 1,” and pay just compensation, therefore.

**Section 3.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
