

SHA RESOLUTION NO. 2322

A RESOLUTION GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE GLEN CREEK AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECT BY MEANS OF A CONSTRUCTION MANAGER/GENERAL CONTRACTOR (CMGC) AND AUTHORIZING SELECTION BY REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)

WHEREAS, the Commission of the Salem Housing Authority acts as the Local Contract Review Board for the Housing Authority of the City of Salem (SHA) pursuant to ORS 279A.060 and Public Contracting Rules (PCR) 1.3; and

WHEREAS, ORS 279C.335(2) and PCR 9.7 authorize the Local Contract Review Board to exempt a public improvement contract or a class of public improvement contracts from competitive bidding requirements upon the adoption of certain written findings after a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the SHA has adopted its own PCR pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 279A.065; and

WHEREAS, PCR 10.2 authorizes an alternative form of procurement known as the CM/GC contract; and

WHEREAS, a CM/GC contract may be authorized if certain types of benefits resulting from its use are reasonably demonstrated; and

WHEREAS, one primary goal of the SHA, is to provide affordable housing in the city; and

WHEREAS, SHA is seeking to develop affordable housing units owned by the SHA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 279C.335(5) and PCR 9.7(c), the SHA published notice of the March 23, 2026 public hearing on the draft findings in the *Daily Journal of Commerce*, a trade newspaper of general statewide circulation, on March 9, 2026, which date is not less than ten business days prior to the public hearing;

WHEREAS, the Commission determines that the Glen Creek Redevelopment project should be completed by CM/GC.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON, ACTING AS THE LOCAL CONTRACT REVIEW BOARD FOR THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Commission adopts the Findings set forth in Exhibit A to this Resolution.

Section 2. The exemption of the CM/GC contract from competitive bidding will promote competition and will not encourage favoritism, because the CM/GC will be chosen by a competitive RFP process, and the major portion of the renovation work will be performed by subcontractors chosen by competitive bidding.

Section 3. The contract for renovation of the Glen Creek Renovation project by CM/GC is exempt from competitive bidding, and the CM/GC shall be selected by the RFP process in accordance with the SHA's public contracting rules and the process described in the Findings.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
