RECOMMENDATION OF PLANNING COMMISSION NORTH GATEWAY URBAN RENEWAL AREA SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, The North Gateway Urban Renewal Area (NGURA) Plan was adopted on December 10, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment will increase the maximum indebtedness from \$75 million to \$101,466,402; and

WHEREAS, new projects are being added to the plan which align with the goals and objectives of the existing NGURA Plan while also conforming to the Salem Comprehensive Plan;

WHEREAS, the North Gateway Advisory Board has been involved in the decision making; and

WHEREAS, outreach was conducted with the Northgate Neighborhood Association; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to an urban renewal plan requires review and recommendation by the Planning Commission; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON:

Section 1. FINDINGS:

The Planning Commission hereby adopts as its findings of fact the staff report on this matter dated March 5, 2019, herewith attached and by this reference incorporated herein.

Section 2. ORDER:

Based upon the foregoing findings and conclusions, the Planning Commission RECOMMENDS the City Council take the following action:

That the City Council adopt the amendment to the North Gateway Urban Renewal Plan as it is in accordance with the Comprehensive Plan.
