

## ORDINANCE BILL NO. 08-25

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PAID PARKING IN THE DOWNTOWN PARKING DISTRICT; AMENDING SECTIONS 102.005, 102.040, 102.045, 102.050, 102.060, 102.065, 102.067 AND 102.135.

*The City of Salem ordains as follows:*

**Section 1.** SRC chapter 102 – Parking – is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein.

**Section 2. Findings.** The proposed amendments are consistent with Oregon law and the purpose and intent of the chapter, to provide for paid parking within the Downtown Parking District and the enforcement thereof and are in the public interest. With the initiation of paid parking in downtown, the Salem City Council will determine, by June 30, 2026, whether to continue, modify or repeal the Downtown Parking Tax as provided for in SRC chapter 7.

**Section 3. Codification.** In preparing this ordinance for publication and distribution, the City Recorder shall not alter the sense, meaning, effect or substance of this ordinance, but within such limitations, may:

- (a) Renumber sections and parts of sections of the ordinance;
- (b) Rearrange sections;
- (c) Change reference numbers to agree with renumbered chapters, sections or other parts;
- (d) Delete references to repealed sections;
- (e) Substitute the proper subsection, section or chapter, or other division numbers;
- (f) Change capitalization and spelling for the purpose of uniformity;
- (g) Add headings for purposes of grouping like sections together for ease of reference; and
- (h) Correct manifest clerical, grammatical or typographical errors.

**Section 4. Severability.** Each section of this ordinance, and any part thereof, is severable, and if any part of this ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
