Do those plans also include demolishing the RunAWay Art and Craft Studio building? If so, has there been consideration of preserving the historical south wall of that building? This intact wall remains from the building that Dr. John Minthorn constructed in 1889 for his business, the Oregon Land Office. His young nephew, Herbert Hoover, spent a lot of time in that office helping his uncle between 1889 and 1891. Few artifacts from the time Dr. Minthorn and Herbert Hoover lived in Salem still exist. The remaining window and architectural structures are completely intact and are very striking. Sorry to ramble, but I'm concerned. Thanks, Howard Baumann, MD</p>
