Through its annual City Council Policy Agenda, City Council makes its initial priorities for action clear to staff and the community and provides direction on aligning resources towards the Strategic Plan Policy areas through the City's budgeting process. In a November work session, Council considers progress achieved on Policy Agenda priorities from the year before, community feedback from the Community Satisfaction Survey, updates on major initiatives, and begins identifying priorities for 2022. In January, staff return with proposals for how to achieve City Council priorities. In April, the City's budgeting process begins, with final City Council action taken in June.
