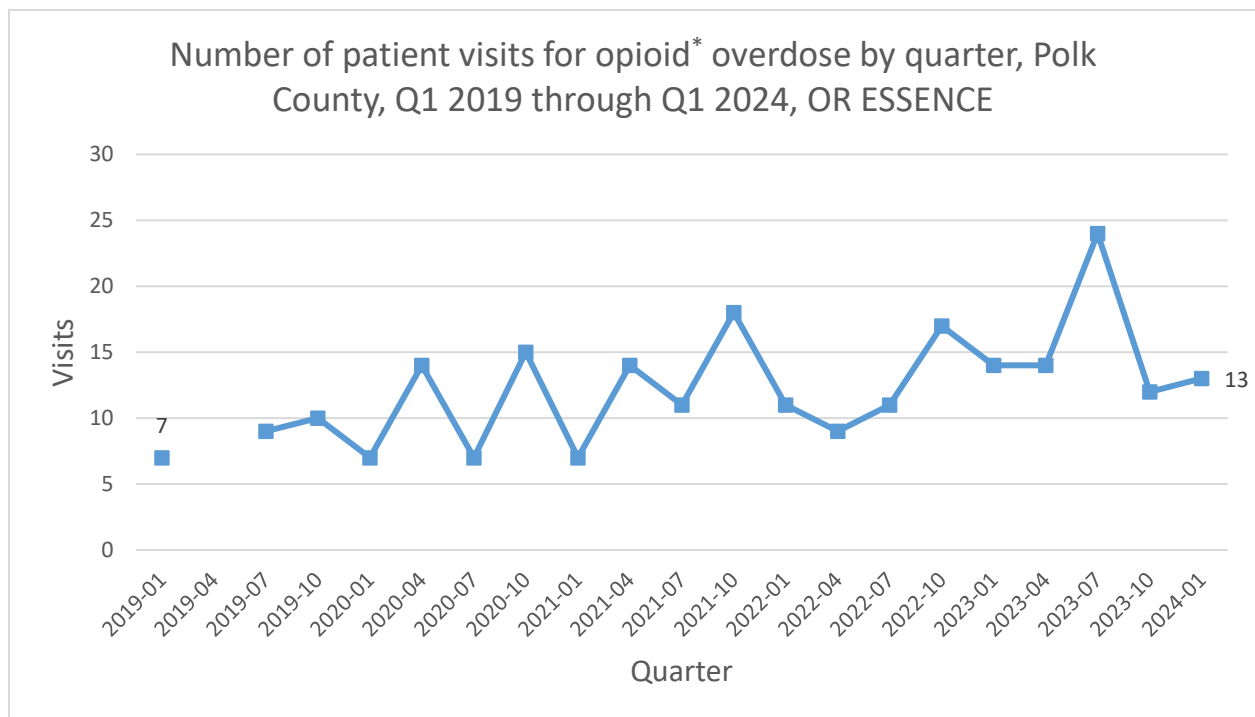
Polk County ESSENCE Opioid Overdose Surveillance 2019-2024

To evaluate Polk County resident patient visits to urgent care or emergency departments for opioid overdose using the ESSENCE surveillance system.

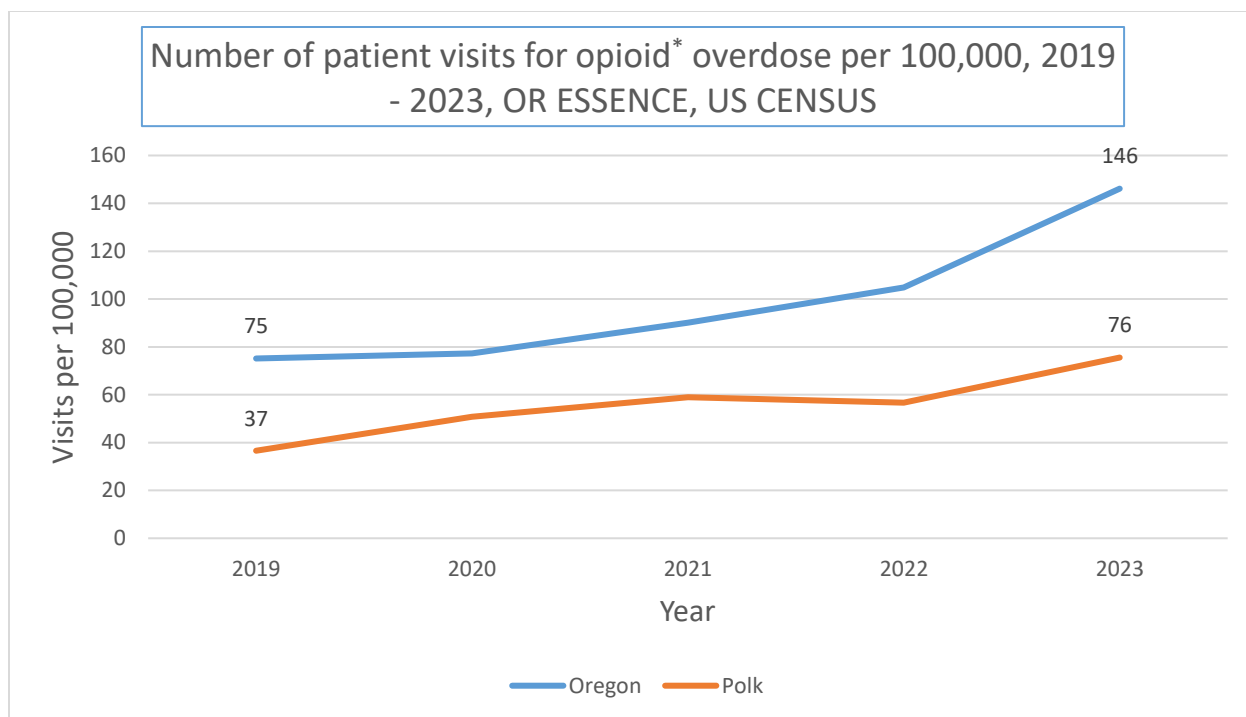
Note:

All counts and rates are based on the patient's residence and not the location of where they are seen for care.

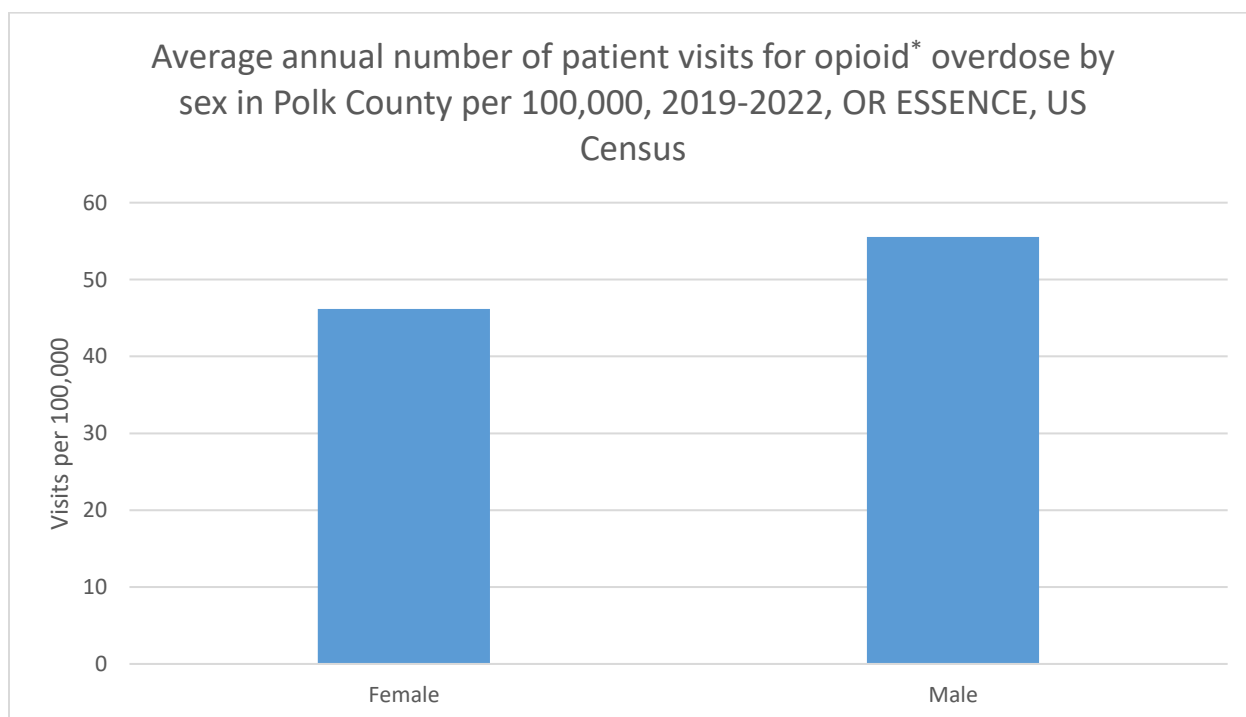

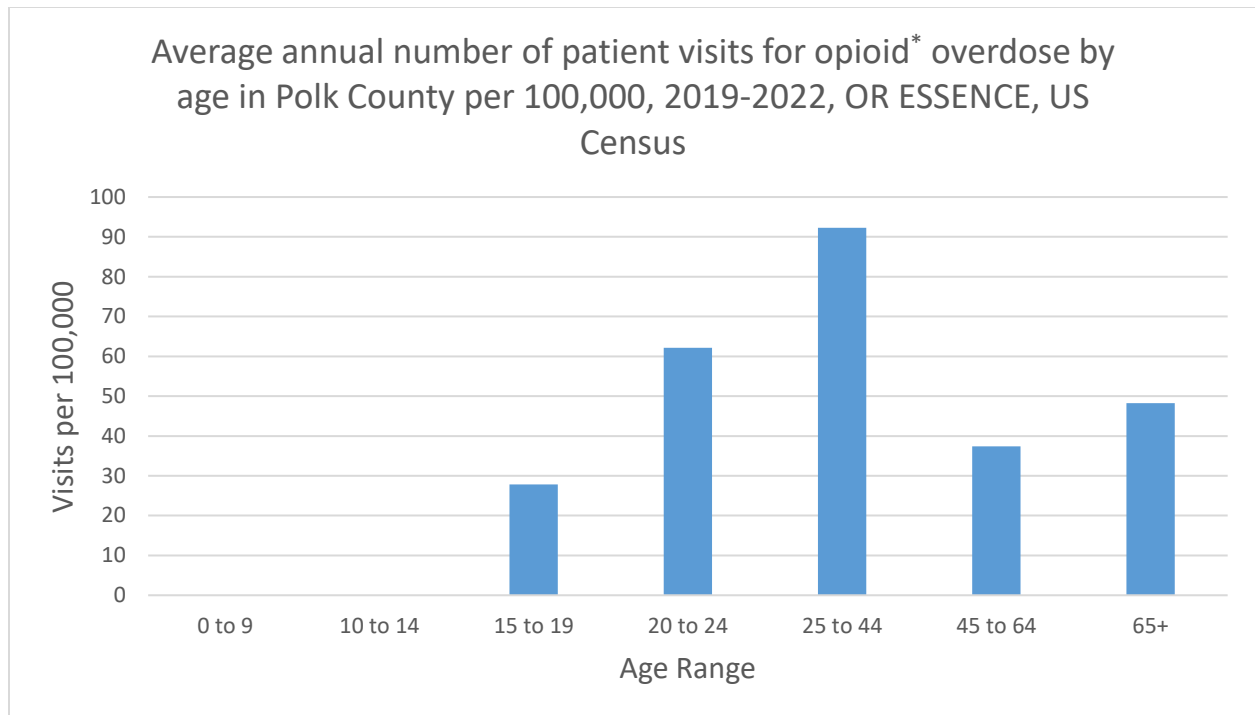

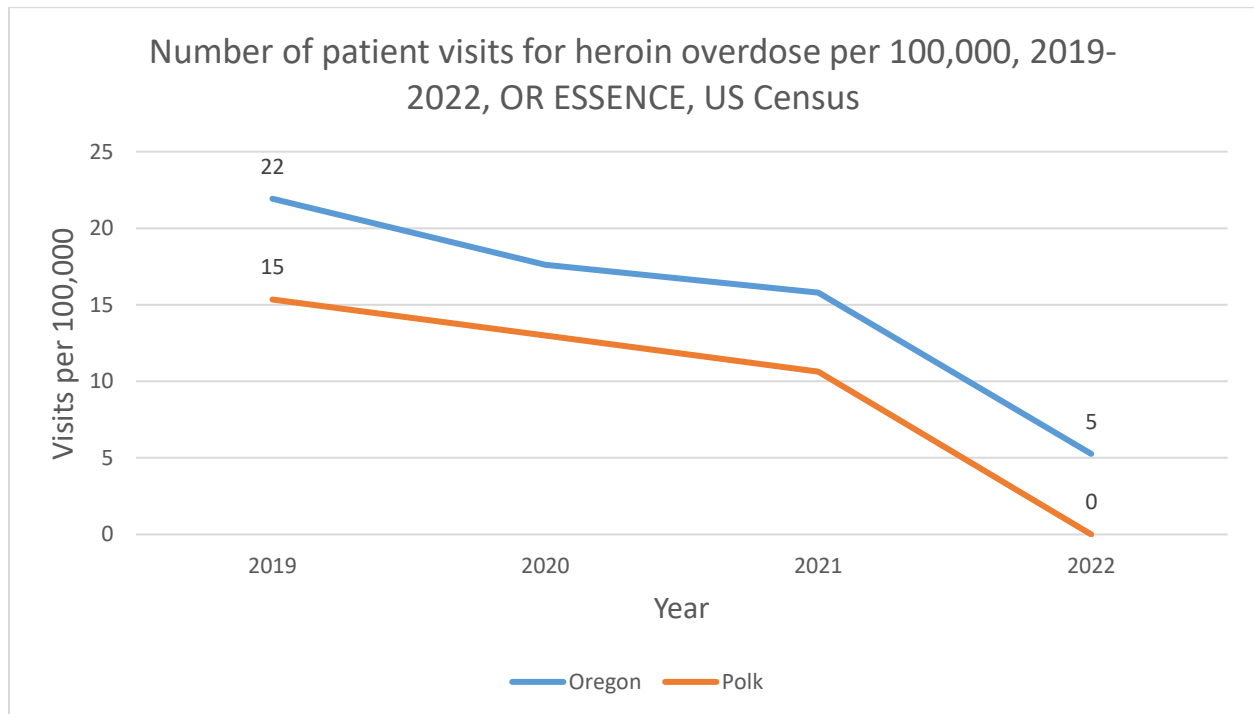
