1. Contingency EXCLUDES Escalation
2. Line J - Budget provided by City of Salem based recent and comparable sales
3. Off Site Construction would be funded through Urban Renewal for Liberty & Division Intersection Improvements
4. Line B: structured parking cut in half to 50 police cars
5. SWAT vehicles to stay at Window To West (5 mins. away) for cost reduction
6. Line A: set goal of \$250 per sq.ft. instead of \$299. Line M covers it.
7. Line M: use same contingency as Beaverton: 5%
8. Keep all consultants local. Use Beaverton consultant as an advisor (hourly fee)
9. Percentages are based on G.C. total general construction contract amount (line A+B+C) \$31.2M
10. Seismic costs are from MSC Engineering reports & Dalke Construction estimates (total \$15M)
11. Architectural/Electrical/Mechanical allowance of \$5M to address damage caused by structural work.
12. SCV recommends add \$0.5M to cover police move, and the library moving during seismic work
