Unresolved questions

About a year ago, I began asking City of Salem for the properly delegated authority, which it claimed to possess, to issue trafficking tickets to "the general public". Judge Aiken was asked, Deputy Chief Steve Belshaw was asked and finally in August, I asked City of Salem Council. Inspection of public records is a right "the people" have, not only "the people", but "persons"/corporate entities as well. The public record law is encoded at ORS 192.420. This citation was frequently used. No such public record, also known as "law", was ever produced.

The felony crime of "Racketeering" is being committed by certain officers of City of Salem, as established by acquiescence. Your duty as public officers includes to correct me if I am wrong about this.

Consequently, City of Salem Attorney, Dan Atchison "instructed" city personnel not to talk to me. He also, apparently unilaterally, banned me from City of Salem property, with the exception being attendance at City Council meetings. I responded that I could be persuaded to go along with this in exchange for \$1,000 per month. This suggestion was rejected, so Dan Atchison has most recently been asked to come to this meeting prepared to answer the following questions, posed hereunder as requests for public records pursuant to ORS 192.420:

Provide the public record for my inspection that properly delegates authority to Dan Atchison to ban "the people", including me, from City of Salem/public property.

Provide the public record for my inspection that describes my actions which may, but may not be, legitimate grounds for banishment from City of Salem/public property.

Provide for my inspection the public record that informs "the people" just how long the Police Department of City of Salem's Internal Affairs Unit has to determine whether Deputy Chief Steve Bellshaw has deliberately engaged in the misrepresentation of a material fact, when he said the authority to cite the general public for "trafficking" offenses "is in a recent revision of the Vehicle Code". I made my complaint to Internal Affairs in October of last year.

The Oregon Evidence Code say "Evidence willfully suppressed is adverse to the party suppressing", Rule 311(c).
