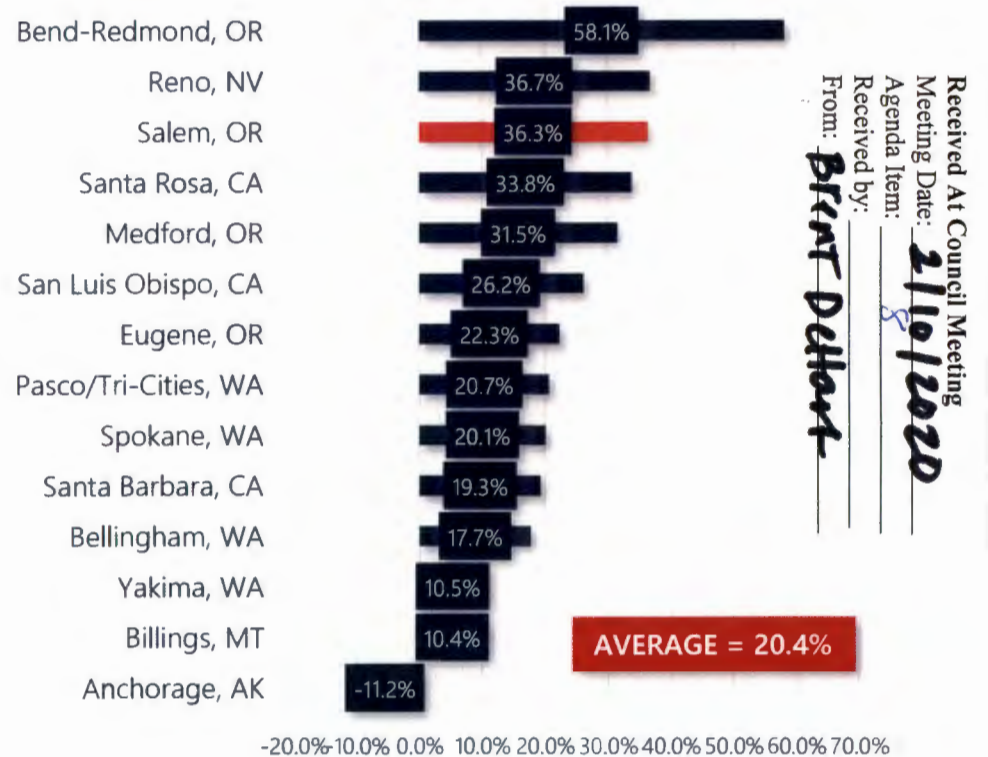

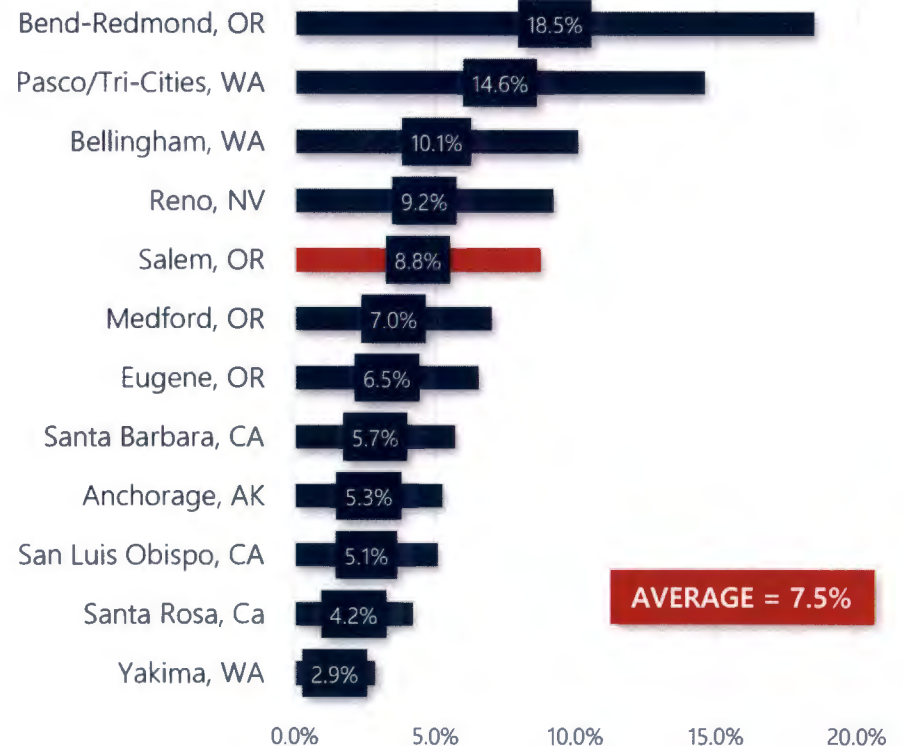

- Salem is **growing the fastest in all of Oregon**, outside Portland.
- The Salem metro area is **13% larger than Eugene**, which supports five airlines, 15 departures per day, and an average of 1,551 passengers per day each way (PDEW).
- The Salem metro area is **95% larger than Medford**, which supports five airlines, 13 departures per day, and an average of 1,345 passengers per day each way (PDEW).
- The Salem metro area is **127% larger than Bend-Redmond**, which supports five airlines, 12 departures per day, and an average of 1,179 passengers per day each way (PDEW).
