

# **Micro Shelter Site Options**

Addresses City Council Strategic Priority of Addressing Homelessness Supports City Goal Result Areas: Welcoming and Livable Community, and, Safe Community

**Objective:** Identify suitable land parcel(s) to place managed micro shelter village(s)

Proposal:

- Prioritize people aged 55+ and who are women or people who identify as non-binary feminine leaning
- Contract with experienced nonprofit provider to manage site
- Provide services at location, including case management, food, showers, and transportation
- Ensure on-site plan includes safety team members, fencing, written guest expectations

# Issues

- Need to augment site with:
  Parking at Windows to the
  - 2-3 office spaces (for case management, at City Hall)
  - Location for showers (inside City Hall, or, 35k+ cost for shower tent at Windows to the West)
- Removes space from public access for event scheduling

#### Nonprofit operator owned property - 2410 Turner Rd SE

#### Benefits

- Owned by non-profit operator who delivers micro shelter services
- Access to water and electrical
- Close to public transport





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- Soonest it could open is summer 2022
- Requires paving
- Requires change to draft Ordinance Bill No 13-21 allowing the location of managed temporary villages within the 500-year floodplain, and within the 100-year floodplain as approved under Chapter 601 of the Salem Revised Code
