

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-46**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2022-42

**Whereas**, on July 11, 2022, the City Council of the City of Salem, Oregon (the “City”) adopted Resolution No. 2022-42 calling for a measure election (the “Measure Election”) for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the city the question of authorizing the City to issue general obligation bonds (“City of Salem Community Capital Improvements Bond”); and

**Whereas**, on July 19, 2022, the ballot title, caption, and summary for the measure election were published in the *Statesman Journal* and no appeals of the ballot title were received; and

**Whereas**, the published ballot title included specific references to affordable housing, libraries, and technology, which were omitted from the ballot title reviewed by City Council on July 11, 2022; and

**Whereas**, to avoid potential obstacles to use of the bond funds consistent with Council and voter approval it is necessary for City Council to approve the modified ballot title language.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Salem resolves as follows:

**Section 1. Amendment to Resolution No. 2022-42.** Exhibit A to Resolution No. 2022-42 is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and by this reference incorporated therein. Actions taken after the adoption of Resolution No. 2022-42 to finalize and publish the ballot title for the Measure Election are hereby ratified by the City Council.

**Section 8. Effective Date.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.

Shall Salem issue up to \$300,000,000 in bonds for streets, fire equipment, parks, affordable housing, libraries, technology, and public safety? If approved, the bonds would be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.
