2	AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SRC CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTERING OATHS;		
2	CREATING NEW PROVISIONS.		
3	The City of Salem ordains as follows:		
4	Section 1. SRC 2.040 is added to SRC chapter 2 as set forth herein:		
~	SRC 2.040. – Administering Oaths. An oath required or allowed under this Code or the		
5	Salem Charter may be administered by any City elected official, the City Attorney, a		
6	notary public, or a judge or magistrate of any court of record in the state of Oregon.		
7	Oaths shall be in writing and signed by both the person taking and administering the oath.		
Section 2. Findings. Oaths of office are required for certain positions created and			
8	allowed by the Salem Charter and the Salem Revised Code. Oregon law permits local		
9	jurisdictions to designate the appropriate authority to administer oaths. Therefore, it is in		
10	the public interest and appropriate for the Salem City Council to designate who may		
10	administer oaths required or allowed under the Salem Charter or Salem Revised Code.		
11	Section 3. Codification. In preparing this ordinance for publication and distribution, the		
12	City Recorder shall not alter the sense, meaning, effect or substance of this ordinance, but		
13	within such limitations, may:		
	(a) Renumber sections and parts of sections of the ordinance;		
14	(b) Rearrange sections;		
15	(c) Change reference numbers to agree with renumbered chapters, sections or other		
	parts;		
16	(d) Delete references to repealed sections;		
17	(e) Substitute the proper subsection, section or chapter, or other division numbers;		
18	(f) Change capitalization and spelling for the purpose of uniformity;		
10	(g) Add headings for purposes of grouping like sections together for ease of		
19	reference; and		
20	(h) Correct manifest clerical, grammatical or typographical errors.
