## **RESOLUTION NO. 2023-2**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TRANSFERS OF APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND, AIRPORT FUND, AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND.

**Whereas,** on January 9, 2023, the City Council reviewed requirements for commercial air service at the Salem Municipal Airport; and

Whereas, these requirements included significant additional operating, personnel, and capital costs to accommodate commercial air service; and

Whereas, the number of full-time equivalent (FTE) employees needed to complete these requirements are insufficient; and

Whereas, the Airport Fund does not have adequate funding or budget authority to complete these requirements; and

Whereas, budget authority and authorized positions for this project were not included in the fiscal year 2023 budget; and

**Whereas**, ORS 294.463 allows the City Council to authorize transfers of appropriations within a given fund or between funds by ordinance or resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Transfer of appropriations totaling \$2,366,000 are hereby approved as set forth below:

FOR: Transfer of contingency in the General Fund to pay for operational and capital costs associated with commercial air service at the Salem Municipal Airport.

FROM: General Fund, Non Departmental, Contingency, 101-60961000-61110, \$2,366,000

TO: General Fund, Non Departmental, Transfers to other funds, 101-60961000-62110, \$2,166,000

TO: General Fund, Fire EOD, Salaries & wages, 101-37202500-51010, \$200,000

- ADD: Capital Improvements Fund, UD Airport Construction, Interfund transfers, 255-64903000-39110, \$1,900,000
- ADD: Capital Improvements Fund, UD Airport Construction, Construction Contracts, 255-64903000-52620, \$1,900,000
- ADD: Airport Fund, UD Airport, Interfund transfers, 160-64131500-39110, \$266,000
- ADD: Airport Fund, UD Airport, Salaries & wages, 160-64131500-51010, \$184,100

ADD: Airport Fund, UD Airport, Controlled equipment, 160-64131500-52815, \$81,900

Section 2. Authorize addition of position totaling 9.0 FTE hereby approved as set forth below:

Airport Fund: 5.0 FTE

General Fund: 4.0 FTE Police Department: 1.0 FTE Fire Department: 3.0 FTE
