## END NOTES TO CHANGE ORDERS:

- **1.** Change Order No. 1 adds \$25,231.20. Provides for a City directed change to include hazardous materials assessment and demolition plans and specifications for the stormwater detention basin.
- **2. Change Order No. 1 adds \$35,395.75.** Provides for an existing sewer main that was discovered with severe corrosion issues within the project and will require additional design and construction costs for cured-in-place pipe rehabilitation. This change removes the waterline replacement from the project scope and replaces it with this rehabilitation.
- 3. Change Order No. 1 adds \$120,000. Provides for work to assist with the revenue task force.
