At the initial presentation to Grant Neighborhood on March 2, 2017, Seed of Faith Ministries' representative, Evelyn McCoy-Harris, had to leave to attend to other commitments before neighbors in attendance had a chance to fully discuss the Conditional Use proposal. This resulted in our letter to you on March 12, 2017 which included a list of unanswered questions and concerns.

Ms. McCoy-Harris was able to return to our April 6, 2017 meeting and discussed the Ministries' contacts with surrounding neighbors, as well as the Boys & Girls Club and Grant Community School. She also clarified the drop-off and pickup schedule and reported that it will be Seed of Faith vans, not public school busses, which will transport school age children to the site for the after school program. With these issues resolved, the Grant Neighborhood Association voted unanimously to support the applicant's Conditional Use request.
