- **1. Change Order No. 1 adds \$128,505:** Provides for extending the project management assignment until June 30, 2019 in order to help facilitate the delivery of various large complex projects for the City.
- **2.** Change Order No. 1 adds \$52,648: Provides for the evaluation of the impact of adding wells to the Aquifer system at or near Woodmansee Park and will include upsizing and addition of pipes in the water distribution system.
- **3.** Change Order No. 3 adds \$8,284,593: Provides for an early work package consisting of cast-in-place structural concrete, labor of JE Dunn staff, and material and maintenance expenses such as field office rental, temporary utilities, and trash collection.
- **4.** Change Order No. 1 adds \$375,000: Additional funds are required to complete computer and IT-related hardware purchases for City departments for the remainder of the fiscal year.
- **5.** Change Order No. 1 adds \$300,000: Provides for cleaning the roughing filter sand to prepare for the next algal bloom season in 2019.
