I am a Certified Senior Adviser (CSA), Certified Cognitive Stimulation Instructor (CCSI) and a Certified Alzheimer Educator (CAEd) which I use daily in my interactions with Seniors and/or their family members. I also co-host a radio show on KМУZ FM in Salem called Aging In The Willamette Valley where we discuss all things related to aging: senior centers, medicare, long term care insurance, funeral planning, pain management, home modification, alternative types of healthcare, elder law, etc. The show is an attempt to educate our listeners on the resources available to them in our area because many times people just don't know what is "out there" or how to find a particular resource. I speak to many experts in our area about all of these topics and more, on a weekly basis. Mayor Bennett and Marilyn Daily have been guests on the radio show. I also manage the email list and hosting locations for the Senior Lifestyles Networking group in Salem which meets monthly and contains a cross section of people who deal with seniors: facility directors/marketers, home care agencies, hospice, elder law attorneys, insurance agents, senior centers, Kroc Center, hospital staff, medical equipment vendors, Northwest Seniors & Disabilities staff, etc.
