- 1. Change Order No. 2 adds \$278,120: Provides for full time project management services on large projects.
- **2.** Change Order No. 1 adds \$90,507: Provides for the 100% submittal review, design clarification, and change order review. Lead the startup and commissioning of the cogeneration facility, conduct training of City staff for operation of the facility, and attend additional project meetings with the construction contractor.
- **3.** Change Order No. 1 adds \$394,300: Provides for work through completion and commissioning of the short term water treatment projects.
- **4.** Change Order No. 1 adds \$284,327: Provides for 100% submittal review, design clarifications, and change order review. Lead the startup and commissioning of the dewatering and thickening facilities, conduct training for City staff for operation of the facility, and attend additional weekly project meetings with the construction contractor through the duration of the project. Lead development of a redundant dewatering contingency plan during construction.
- **5. Change Order No. 3 adds \$100,126:** Provides for the coordination of the fabrication and placement of art throughout the new police facility and to include landscape architectural services to place the art in the public plaza landscaping. This change order also provides for additional geotechnical inspection site visits for this project.
- **6. Change Order No. 2 adds \$116,580:** Provides for furniture, fixtures, and equipment to be defined and added to the scope of work.
- **7. Change Order No. 2 adds \$42,823:** Provides for overtime required to meet the project schedule, changes in the control panel and battery backup design, expedited fees for components, and other items needed to complete the project prior to the 2019 Algal Toxin season.
