NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

September 20, 2016, 7:00 a.m. Salem Hospital Board Room 665 Winter Street, S.E. Salem, Oregon 97301

A public hearing will be held on Tuesday, September 20, 2016 at 7:00 a.m. at Salem Haspital, in the Board Room, 665 Winter Street, S.E., Salem, Oregon 97301, with respect to the proposed issuance by The Haspital Facility Authority at the City of Salem, Oregon (the "Authority") of its Revenue Bonds (Salem Health Projects), in one or more series pursuant to a plan of finance, with an aggregate issue price not to exceed \$225,000,000 (the "Bonds").

THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON THE BONDS WILL NOT CONSTITUTE A DEBT OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON (THE "CITY"), NOR SHALL THE BONDS BE PAYABLE FROM A TAX OF ANY NATURE LEVIED UPON ANY PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY NOR WITHIN ANY OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF OREGON. THE BONDS WILL BE PAYABLE ONLY FROM THE REVENUES AND RESOURCES PROVIDED BY THE BORROWER. THE AUTHORITY HAS NO TAXING POWER.

The proceeds of the Bonds will be used to make a loan to Salem Health (DBA Salem Hospital), a nanprofit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Oregan and an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Borrower"), for the purpose of refinancing outstanding debt obligations of the Issuer that financed or refinanced the now completed cogital construction, renovation, improvement, furnishing and equipping of projects located at: (i) the Center for Outpatient Medicine located at 875 Ook Street, S.E., Salem, Oregon 97301; (ii) a parking structure and mechanical building located at 655 Capital Street, S.E., Salem, Oregon 97301 and sky bridges connecting the parking structure, the existing hospital located at 655 Winter Street, S.E., Salem, Oregon 97301 and the Center for Outpatient Medicine located at 675 Ook Street, S.E., Salem, Oregon 97301; (iii) a hermity Birth Center located at 939 Ook Street, S.E., Salem, Oregon 97301; (iv) the Earling Birth Center located at 939 Ook Street, S.E., Salem, Oregon 97301; (vi) the surface parking located between Capital Street and University Street, and Ook Street and Mission Street, S.E., Salem, Oregon 97301; (vi) the potient tower located at 870 Ook Street S.E., Salem, Oregon 97301; (vii) the hospital tower located at 665 Winter Street, S.E., Solem, Oregon 97301; (vii) the hospital tower located at 665 Winter Street, S.E., Solem, Oregon 97301; (viii) the Regional Laboratory located at 3260 State Street, S.E., Salem, Oregon 97301; (viii) the Nospital tower located at 1049 Ook Street S.E., 1112 Ook Street S.E., 1118 Ook Street S.E., 1127 Ook Street S.E., 300 State Street S.E., 1128 Ook Street S.E., 300 Capital Street S.E., 30

The Barrower will be the owner of all assets financed and refinanced by the Bands.

Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, requires that qualified 501(c)(3) bands be approved by the applicable elected representatives of the governmental unit issuing such bands and by the governmental unit having jurisdiction over the area in which the Projects, or any partions thereof, are located. For the Authority to issue the Bands, it is necessary that the City Council of the City of Salem, Oregan, as the elected representatives of the Authority, approve of the Bands.

The purpose of the public hearing will be to provide a reasonable apportunity for members of the public to express their views, arally or in writing, regarding the issuance of the Bands and the uses and purposes of the proceeds of the Bands. The hearing will be conducted in a manner that provides a reasonable apportunity for persons with differing views to be heard on the question of the issuance of the Bands. Written comments also may be delivered at the public hearing or mailed to the Authority at the address indicated above.
