

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-48

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXPENDING AN OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT GRANT AWARD IN THE GENERAL FUND

Whereas, the City of Salem, Oregon Police Department has been awarded a 2016 Oregon Military Department Office of Emergency Management State Homeland Security Program grant; and

Whereas, the City Council, on this same date, authorized the City Manager to accept and execute all documents associated with the grant award; and

Whereas, the current expenditure appropriation in the Police Department's FY 2016-17 budget does not include the expenses associated with this grant award; and

Whereas, the ORS 294.463 allows the City Council to authorize transfers of appropriations within a fund; and

Whereas, the transfer of appropriation authority from General Fund, Contingency to General Fund, Police Department, Materials and Services authorized by Resolution 2016-48 provides the increased appropriation authority to expend the grant award in the Police Department's budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby adopts Resolution 2016-48 to transfer appropriation in the amount of \$77,350 from General Fund, Contingency to General Fund, Police Department, Materials and Services as set forth in "Exhibit A," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
