A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING MUNICIPAL SERVICES PURSUANT TO ORS 221.760(1) TO RECEIVE STATE SHARED REVENUE FROM CIGARETTE, GAS AND LIQUOR TAXES

Whereas, ORS 221.760(1) provides as follows:

The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785 to 366.820, and 471.805 shall disburse such funds in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants, according to the most recent federal decennial census, only if the officer reasonably is satisfied that the city meets the requirements set out in subsection (2) of this section, or if the city provides four or more of the following services:

- a) Police protection;
- b) Fire protection;
- c) Street construction, maintenance, and lighting;
- d) Sanitary sewer;
- e) Storm sewers;
- f) Planning, zoning, and subdivision control;
- g) One or more utility services; and

Whereas, the City Council desires to establish compliance with ORS 221.760(1) by certifying the provision of four or more municipal services.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City of Salem certifies that it provides four or more municipal services enumerated in ORS 221.760(1):

ATTEST:

- a) Police protection;
- b) Fire protection;
- c) Street construction, maintenance, and lighting;
- d) Sanitary sewers;
- e) Storm sewers;
- f) Planning, zoning, and subdivision control;
- g) Municipal water utility service.

Section 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
