

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-9

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING SECURITY SERVICES AT CENTER 50+

Whereas, the City's FY 2018 adopted budget for the Recreation Services Division did not include the provision of security services at Center 50+; and

Whereas, Center 50+ has experienced an influx of attendees with varying behaviors prompting an increase in disturbances and violations of the Center's Code of Conduct; and

Whereas, Center 50+ has utilized security services from DePaul Employment Services for the past two months realizing a decrease in reported incidents and conduct violations; and

Whereas, the transfer of appropriation authority authorized by Resolution 2018-9 provides the budget actions necessary to provide funding to continue security services at Center 50+ through the end of the current fiscal year; and

Whereas, ORS 294.463 allows the City Council to authorize transfers of appropriations within a given fund or between funds by ordinance or resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby adopts Resolution 2018-9 to transfer appropriation in the amount of \$28,000 from the General Fund, Non Departmental, Contingencies to General Fund, Recreation Services, Materials and Services as set forth in "Exhibit A," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
