

## RESOLUTION NO. 2233

### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE SECTION 811 - MAINSTREAM NON-ELDERLY DISABLED VOUCHERS

**Whereas**, the primary goal of the Marion-Polk Ten Year Plan to End Homelessness is to increase the supply of housing options for low-income and very low-income residents to prevent and end homelessness; and,

**Whereas**, the City of Salem has identified ending homelessness as the top priority in the Housing and Community Development Consolidated Plan and through support of the Marion-Polk Ten Year Plan to End Homelessness; and,

**Whereas**, the City of Salem has identified connecting Continuum of Care participants to mainstream housing and community development resources to help them progress toward self-sufficiency as a goal in the Housing and Community Development Consolidated Plan; and,

**Whereas**, the Housing Authority of the City of Salem is committed to developing transitional and permanent supportive housing to implement the City of Salem's priority to end homelessness; and,

**Whereas**, the Housing Authority has identified a funding opportunity through the Section 811 – Mainstream NED Vouchers which, if successful, would provide rental assistance up to 500 homeless families.

NOW THEREFORE, THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The Housing Authority is hereby authorized to submit an application for funding through the Family Unification Program.
