 The Salem Public Library has requested using \$113,400 of unanticipated savings from its General Fund operating budget to support relocation costs in preparation for the bond-funded seismic upgrade project. To access the savings in FY 2019, the \$113,400 must be carried over from FY 2018 to the Library's General Fund FY 2019 budget. The carryover of \$113,400 will then be transferred to the relocation project in the Library's cost center of the FY 2019 Capital Improvements Fund budget. The action involving the Library's cost center in the Capital Improvements Fund budget is considered the indirect carryover.
