

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-13

AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATION IN THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF FACILITATING THE REPLACEMENT OF THE 9-1-1 TELEPHONE SYSTEM.

Whereas, the City's 9-1-1 telephone system is due for replacement; and

Whereas, replacement of the system is paid by the Oregon Office of Emergency Management; and

Whereas, a recent change in practice by the Oregon Office of Emergency Management now requires the City to be responsible for the purchasing process including the commitment to pay through a purchase order; and

Whereas, to comply with the City's longstanding practice of aligning budget authority with a purchasing commitment, a transfer of appropriation authority is necessary from General Fund contingencies; and

Whereas, the transfer of appropriation authorized by Resolution 2019-13 provides the budget actions necessary to move \$1,016,470 from General Fund contingencies to the expenditure category of capital outlay; and

Whereas, ORS 294.463 allows the City Council to authorize transfers of appropriations within a given fund or between funds by ordinance or resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the transfer of appropriation in the amount of \$1,016,470 from General Fund, Non Departmental, Contingency, 101-60961000-61110 to General Fund, Non Departmental, Capital Outlay, 101-60961000-55130, for the purpose of facilitating the replacement of the 9-1-1 telephone system.

Section 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
