## Dear Salem City Council:

As you develop your "2019 City Council Policy Agenda" I strongly recommend you carry over this priority from the 2018 with the additional sentence underlined below.

## Improving Salem Public Library Seismic Safety.

Also in 2017, Salem residents passed an \$18.6 million bond measure to finance seismic, safety, accessibility, and system improvements to the Salem Public Library building and parking garage to ensure continued use of this community resource for decades. <u>Design of the project in 2019 should be in accordance with the Library Collection Development Policy that calls for both a broad and deep core collection of library materials and popular in-demand materials to serve Salem citizens.</u>

In the fall of 2018 over 2,000 books were removed from the non-fiction collection of the Library, including many books of poetry, philosophy and religion, among other subjects. A list of all the books obtained with a public records request was compared to the *Public Library Core Collection Nonfiction* database. Since 1918 the H. W. Wilson Company has published lists of recommended books for libraries. The print edition of *Public Library Core Collection Nonfiction* is now in its 17th edition. The database version is enhanced with both "core" titles and "supplementary titles" that are both recommended as an "opening day collection" for all public libraries of any size.

The following 222 books that have been removed from our library were identified as recommended titles in the Wilson database, about one out of ten of all the books removed. The average publication date of the 222 books was 2004. To replace these books in our library would cost over \$5,000. They now sit in storage at the library awaiting the next Friends of the Library book sale where they will be sold for pennies on the dollar.

Based on the meeting I attended of the Library Advisory Board on January 9th, the Board appears to be very unwilling to recommend that the Collection Development Policy be followed to the letter and that library management call a halt to the mass removal of library books such as the ones above.

The Salem City Council can end this controversy which is doing damage to the reputation of our City and our Library by reaffirming the Collection Development Policy's call for a broad, deep core collection of books such as we have enjoyed at the Salem Public Library for many decades in your "2019 City Council Policy Agenda."
