I am writing to express my support for the preservation of the Salem Peace Mosaic, a joyous, beautiful, and treasured landmark in downtown Salem created by more than 600 community members. The mosaic is scheduled to be demolished due to new construction this fall if funding is not available to preserve this treasure in the City of Salem's Public Art Collection. This mosaic, which shares that Salem means Peace, is located a few blocks from the State Capitol and includes an original poem written for Salem by Oregon Poet Laureate Emerita Paulann Petersen.

The Salem Riverfront Carousel has expressed an interest in incorporating the mosaic into their new building in Salem's regional Riverfront Park. This potential location would be an exciting addition to the park and for Salem.
