

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2245**

**A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO ADMINISTER INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPMENT ACCOUNT (IDA) FUNDS THROUGH A VALLEY INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPMENT ACCOUNT (VIDA) PARTNERSHIP**

**Whereas**, CASA of Oregon administers the IDA grant funding; and

**Whereas**, Salem Housing Authority has been granted \$72,000 in state matching funds; and

**Whereas**, Salem Housing Authority recognizes a need to reach its under-served diverse population; and

**Whereas**, Salem Housing Authority will evaluate and identify programing that will better serve communities of color, including but not limited to community outreach to culturally specific community groups; and

**Whereas**, Salem Housing Authority will use IDA as a tool to increase access and opportunities for communities of color, end generational poverty.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The Executive Director or his designee is authorized to enter into a partnership agreement with CASA of Oregon to administer grant funding to program participants.

**Section 2.** The Executive Director or his designee is authorized to accept an amount equal to 13 percent of Salem Housing Authority's award for administrative expenses.

**Section 3.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
