END NOTES TO CHANGE ORDERS:

1. Change Order No. 4 adds \$73,814: Provides for a 13-month rental extension of six (6) mixers at Geren Island.

2. Change Order No. 45, 46, and 47 adds \$49,295: Provides for two gate valves to the hot water loop to permit maintenance of the north section without completely draining glycol from the entire system, corrects several Cogeneration Building structural design issues, and the Cogeneration Building roof joist design did not account for the load imposed by the 5,000 pound engine silencer.
