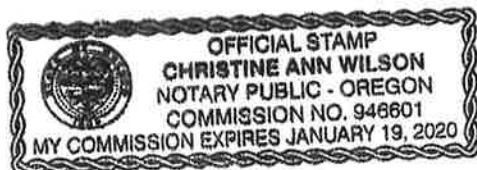

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL OF REVENUE BONDS (YAKIMA VALLEY FARM WORKERS CLINIC PROJECT) ISSUED BY THE HOSPITAL FACILITY AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON

The Salem City Council will hold a public hearing at 6:30 p.m., Monday, July 11, 2016, in the Council Chambers, Civic Center, 555 Liberty Street SE, Salem, Oregon 97301, for the purpose of hearing public comment on a request by Yakima Valley Farm Workers Clinic, a nonprofit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Washington and an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Borrower"), to the Hospital Facility Authority of the City of Salem, Oregon (the "Authority"), to issue debt obligations, in one or more series, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$13,000,000 (the "Bonds"), to finance the costs of, or the reimbursement for, the acquisition, design, development, remodel, construction, improvements, renovations and equipping of a multi-service clinic, including, but not limited to, medical, dental, pharmacy, laboratory, behavioral health, WIC and community health services, and related facilities (collectively, the "Project").

The Project will be located at 255 Lancaster Drive NE, Salem, Oregon 97301, and will be owned and operated by the Borrower.

Section 147(f) of the Code requires that qualified 501(c)(3) bonds be approved by the applicable elected representatives of the governmental unit issuing such bonds (the Authority), and by the applicable elected representatives of the governmental unit having jurisdiction over the area in which the Project is located (the Marion County Board of Commissioners). The Marion County Board of Commissioners is expected to approve the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority following a public hearing. The City Council of the City, as the applicable elected representatives of the governmental unit having jurisdiction over the Authority, will also consider a resolution approving the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority.

The principal of and interest on the Bonds will not constitute a debt of the City or of Marion County, Oregon (the "County"), nor shall the Bonds be payable from a tax of any nature levied upon any property within the City, the County or any other political subdivision of the State of Oregon. The Bonds will be payable only from the revenues and resources of the Borrower pledged to the payment of the Bonds. The Authority has no taxing power.

The purpose of the public hearing will be to provide a reasonable opportunity for members of the public to express their views, orally or in writing, regarding the issuance of the Bonds and the uses and purposes of the proceeds of the Bonds. The hearing will be conducted in a manner that provides a reasonable opportunity for persons with differing views to be heard on the question of the issuance of the Bonds. Written comments may be delivered at the public hearing or mailed to the City at the address indicated above in care of the City Recorder.

This notice is published pursuant to the public approval requirements of Section 147(f) of the Code and the regulations and rulings issued thereunder.

The staff report and supporting materials will be available online no later than 5:00 p.m., July 8, 2016. Prior to the hearing, any person may review the staff report or file written testimony at the Salem City Recorder's Office, Civic Center, Room 205, Salem, Oregon 97301, 503-588-6097; copies of the staff report will be provided at reasonable cost.
