4	The City of Salem ordains as follows:			
5	Section 1. SRC 37.165 is amended to read as follows:			
6	37.165. Distribution of Moneys from Cultural and Tourism Fund.			
7	(a) Consistent with Section 56 of the Salem Charter, the Director shall distribute moneys from			
8	the Cultural and Tourism Fund for;			
9	(1) Enhancement and beautification of vehicular and pedestrian entrance ways to the city			
10	(2) Urban beautification generally;			
11	(3) Improvements to or operation of major tourist attraction or cultural facilities, and;			
12	(4) Activities performed directly by the City or through contracts which promote use of			
13	Salem for conventions, conferences, seminars, or for general tourism.			
14	(b) 25% of each fiscal year's Transient Lodging Tax net receipts shall be allocated to the City's			
15	Destination Tourism Marketing Organization. In the event the City does not have a current			
16	contract with a Destination Tourism Marketing Organization at the time due for a disbursement			
17	under this section, the funds shall be allocated to uses consistent with subsection (a)(4) of this			
18	section. In the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005 and ending June 30, 2006, the director of			
19	finance shall distribute moneys from the Cultural and Tourism Fund for uses permitted by the			
20	Salem Charter, in the following order:			
21	(1) \$550,000 of the moneys shall first be distributed for the purposes of Conference Center			
22	Support, which shall be allocated as follows:			
23	(A) \$300,000 to the Conference Center Gain / Loss Reserve Account.			
24	(B) \$250,000 to the urban renewal agency for the purposes of Conference Center marketing.			
25	(2) The new tax revenues and interest income, in addition to \$4,565.00 of funds originating from			
26	accumulated contingency, shall then be distributed as follows:			
27	(A) 29.48 percent of the moneys to the City for convention and tourism promotion.			
28	(B) 53.68 percent of the moneys to the City for programs.			
29	(C) 16.84 percent of the moneys to:

- 7 (b) The City Council shall review the percentage allocation under subsection (a) (2) B. of this

- 12 (3) Bush Pottery Shop.

- 18 (c) As used in this section, "urban renewal agency" means the Urban Renewal Agency of the
- 19 City of Salem, Oregon.
- 20 | Section 2. Codification. In preparing this ordinance for publication and distribution, the City
- 21 Recorder shall not alter the sense, meaning, effect or substance of this ordinance, but within such
- 22 | limitations, may:
- 23 (a) Renumber sections and parts of sections of the ordinance;
- 24 **(b)** Rearrange sections;
- 25 (c) Change reference numbers to agree with renumbered chapters, sections or other parts;
- 26 (d) Delete references to repealed sections;
- 27 (e) Substitute the proper subsection, section or chapter, or other division numbers;
- 28 (f) Change capitalization and spelling for the purpose of uniformity;
- 29 (g) Add headings for purposes of grouping like sections together for ease of reference; and
- 30 **(h)** Correct manifest clerical, grammatical or typographical errors.
