I believe I would contribute in many ways with my experience and knowledge of 18 years working in low-income housing. I have had much success in partnering with both public and private organizations in order to meet the housing needs of many low-income, elderly and disabled individuals and families. I have extensive knowledge and experience working with requests for proposals in various kinds of work while maintaining compliance with procurement policies for public agencies. I currently oversee an annual budget of over \$1.5 million providing services to area residents.

I have lived in Salem most of my life except for 5 years living in Nashville, TN working in the music business. After returning to Oregon, I promoted and planned a successful concert bringing music legend Crystal Gayle to the Elsinore Theater. This was a big event as the Elsinore was in the middle of extensive renovations. I followed the event at the Elsinore with a successful concert by country music singer Patty Loveless at the new stadium for the Salem-Keizer Volcanoes baseball team in 1998. This was the first such event at this location and involved many area businesses to build an outdoor stage and prepare the venue for such a concert.
