RESOLUTION NO. 2017-47

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPORTING A REGIONAL HOMELESSNESS PROGRAM

Whereas, the City Council's 2017 Strategic Plan has identified homelessness as a priority initiative with the desired outcome of reducing the number of chronically homeless in the community.

Whereas, the Mid-Willamette Valley Council of Governments has been tasked with providing a regional structure to the outcome of reducing homelessness in Marion and Polk counties; and

Whereas, the City of Salem desires to participate in this regional program with a contribution of \$45,000 annually; and

Whereas, the transfer of appropriation authority authorized by Resolution 2017-47 provides the funding to support this effort; and

Whereas, ORS 294.463 allows the City Council to authorize transfers of appropriations within a given fund or between funds by ordinance or resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby adopts Resolution 2017-47 to transfer appropriation in the amount of \$45,000 from the General Fund, Non Departmental, Contingency to General Fund, Non Departmental Materials and Services as set forth in "Exhibit A," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
