

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT FROM THE OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO FUND IMPROVEMENTS TO BILL RIEGLE PARK.

**WHEREAS**, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the Local Government Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to participate in the Local Government Grant Program to the greatest extent possible, as a means of providing needed park and recreation acquisitions, improvements, and enhancements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has identified the continued development of Bill Riegel Park a high priority need in the City of Salem; and

**WHEREAS**, grant funds received would be used to complete site improvements at Bill Riegel Park including, but not limited to, a picnic shelter and concrete plaza, play equipment, trails and walkways, trees and vegetated landscape, and site furnishings;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Salem has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligation related to this grant application should the grant funds be awarded; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Salem will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this park and recreation facility should the grant funds be awarded.

**NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Authorization.** The City Manager for the City of Salem is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, accept on behalf of the City, a Local Government Grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department for improvements at Bill Riegel Park as specified in the Resolution.

**Section 2. Certification.** The City of Salem hereby certifies that the matching share needed in order to apply for the grant funds is readily available at the time of the adoption of this Resolution.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
