7	The City of Salem ordains as follows:
8	Section 1. SRC chapter 230 and SRC chapter 300 are hereby amended as set forth in
	Exhibit A , attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein.
9	Section 2. Findings. It is in the public's best interest to maintain the zoning code which
10	establishes criteria for protection of Salem's historic resources, providing a public benefit
	by preserving Salem's past for future generations.
11	Section 3. Codification. In preparing this ordinance for publication and distribution, the
12	City Recorder shall not alter the sense, meaning, effect, or substance of this ordinance,
13	but within such limitations, may:
	(a) Renumber sections and parts of sections of the ordinance;
14	(b) Rearrange sections;
15	(c) Change reference numbers to agree with renumbered chapters, sections or other
	parts;
16	(d) Delete references to repealed sections;
17	(e) Substitute the proper subsection, section or chapter, or other division numbers;
18	(f) Change capitalization and spelling for the purpose of uniformity;
	(g) Add headings for purposes of grouping like sections together for ease of
19	reference; and
20	(h) Correct manifest clerical, grammatical or typographical errors.
21	Section 4. Severability. Each section of this ordinance, and any part thereof, is
	severable, and if any part of this ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent
22	jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

1	Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective thirty days after	ter enactment,
2	unless a notice of appeal is timely filed, in which case the ordinance shall becom	e effective on
	the date the ordinance is deemed acknowledged pursuant to ORS 197.625(2).
