## **Approved Project Description**

The project will consist of replacing approximately 2,600 linear feet of 2-inch and 4-inch PVC pipe with 4-inch and 8-inch ductile iron pipe to City of Salem design standards; the new water lines will be constructed in public rights-of-way within the city limits of Salem and connected to the existing City water system; disconnection from existing well; water meters will be installed at each connection, and five fire hydrants will be installed on the new water lines to meet City fire standards.

Note: The full terms and conditions will be contained in the contract.
