RESOLUTION NO. 2021-26

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING FY 2021 SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET 5 FOR THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON, AMENDING THE ADOPTED BUDGET FOR THE GENERAL FUND BY INCREASING EXPENDITURE APPROPRIATION AUTHORITY AND REVENUES.

Whereas, ORS 294.471(1)(b) authorizes the adoption of a supplemental budget as necessary to respond to a pressing necessity that could not be reasonably foreseen when preparing the original budget or a previous supplemental budget for the current year or current budget period and that requires prompt action; and

Whereas, on February 13, 2021, Oregon Governor Kate Brown declared a state of emergency in multiple counties, including Marion and Polk Counties, due to winter storm conditions; and

Whereas, effective February 14, 2021, the City declared a state of emergency due to winter storm conditions; and

Whereas, the extent and cost of work required to repair storm damage was underestimated in Supplemental Budget Four (4); and

Whereas, appropriate expenditure authority is required to maintain compliance with Oregon budget law to: and

Whereas, ORS 294.481(1) authorizes adoption of a supplemental budget under these circumstances.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby adopts a supplemental budget for the General Fund for FY 2021 as set forth in "Exhibit A" and "Exhibit B," which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
