3.a. <u>17-58</u> Police Facility

Considered reducing the cost of a police facility and refer the Council-preferred option to the May 16, 2017 election. Staff has reviewed ways to reduce the cost of the police facility below the \$82 million measure that was not approved in November. Option 1: If Council chooses to refer only a police facility question, the recommendation is a 127,000 sq. ft. building for a \$69.1 million bond measure. Option 2: If Council determines that seismic upgrades should be included with a police facility question, the recommendation is to include the library (at \$15.3 million) and reduce the police facility to 115,000 square feet (at

\$63.9 million) for a \$79.2 million bond measure.
