**SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND:**

This information report contains the 2017 Annual Report from the Salem Parks and Recreation

Advisory Board. The report highlights accomplishments during 2017 and sets goals for 2018.

## **FACTS AND FINDINGS:**

The Salem Parks and Recreation Advisory Board was first established in June 1952 and has been an active advisory board to Salem City Council for the past 66 years.

*Salem Revised Code* (SRC) Chapter 13 governs the Salem Parks and Recreation Advisory Board and lists its functions as:

- Recommend and advise the Council, Planning Commission, and other bodies, groups, or officials on all matters referred to it.
- To act in the role of community catalyst in the formation and achievement of a comprehensive community-wide parks and recreation system and program to serve the horticultural, environmental, historical, cultural, and leisure needs of all city residents.
- To make and issue reports to Council on studies, research, examination, and other activities as may be required by the Council.
- Those duties as set forth under SRC Chapter 86, Trees on City Owned Property.

The Salem Parks and Recreation Advisory Board meets on the second Thursday of every month at 5:30 p.m. in a Public Works conference room. Board meetings are open to the public.

The Annual Report documents the past year's accomplishments related to parks and recreation, such as: parks planning, park land acquisitions, park improvements, recreational programs, and grant programs. The Annual Report also sets goals for the next year.
