ISSUE:

Shall the Urban Renewal Agency Board approve and provide to City Council the Urban Renewal Agency's Financial Report for Fiscal Year 2016-17?

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve and provide to City Council the Urban Renewal Agency Financial Report for FY 2016-17.

SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND:

Under ORS 457.460, each year an urban renewal agency must prepare a report on its finances and

file that report with the governing body of the municipality where the agency is located.

FACTS AND FINDINGS:

ORS 457.460 requires an urban renewal agency to report:

- 1. The tax increment revenue received in FY 2016-17 and budgeted in FY 2017-18.
- 2. The debt service payments made in FY 2016-17 and budgeted in FY 2017-18.
- 3. The amount of debt issued in FY 2016-17 and budgeted in FY 2017-18.
- 4. The amount and purpose of actual expenditures in FY 2016-17 and budgeted expenditures in FY 2017-18.
- 5. An analysis of the impact, if any, of the urban renewal plan on the tax collections for FY 2016-17 for all taxing districts included under ORS 457.430.

Requirements 1-4 are displayed in the table below and expenditures by project can be found on pages 72-73 in the Annual Financial Report of the Urban Renewal Agency located on the City of Salem's website at:
