**SUMMARY:**

A primary election was held on May 17, 2022, at which time the City of Salem had candidates for Mayor, Councilors 2, 4, 6, and 8 and Municipal Court Judge.

The City Recorder’s office has received a final official canvass of votes cast in the election certified by Marion and Polk County Clerks.

SRC 11.340 states that the Mayor shall proclaim the results of the election immediately upon receipt of the canvass of votes in an election.
